Choose **TWO** case studies from the selected ecosystems at risk, such as, coastal dunes, freshwater wetlands, inter-tidal wetlands, coral reefs, arid areas, alpine areas, rainforests, temperate forests.

Part III: Economic Activity – 33%

The focus of this study is a geographical investigation of economic activity integrating the local and global context. A local case study is undertaken of a business. The business could be an individual enterprise, firm or company such as a family farm, a mine or mining corporation, a hotel, chain of hotels, heritage or tourist site.
